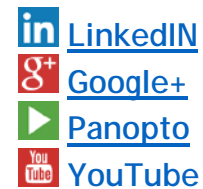
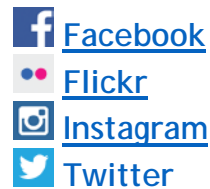
The RCC Scholars Program
